IMPORTANT INFORMATION & MATCH POLICIES

Rules

This match is governed by the current version of IMA-PCC rules – a copy can be downloaded at <https://internationalmultigun.com>. Please be advised that these rules differ in several ways from those of USPSA. To avoid any unfortunate misunderstandings, take the time to download a copy and review it before you arrive. If you have any questions, please ask an Event Official.

First Aid and Competitor Services

The First Aid station will be located in the Registration Building, which will also serve as an information center and handle any lost and found items. AED devices are located throughout the range facility.

Personal Protective Equipment & Hazard Areas

Competitors and spectators are required to wear eye protection at all times and ear protection as appropriate. Climbing on the hillsides or berms is prohibited. Children must be supervised at all times. Please do not cross any hazard lines (denoted by caution tape or rope).

Morning Access, Match Sign-In

Competitors will be allowed to enter the range via the North Gate after 6:15am, and via the South (Main) Gate after 6:30am each match day. Competitors should not enter before 6:15am (unless RVing on-site).

All competitors are required to sign-in at their first stage on their first day. In exchange for your signed waiver, you will receive your competitor badge (which must be presented to Event Officials upon request).

Public Range Access

Registered competitors have free access to the Public Range during match days to check zero, function fire etc. Specific shooting lanes may be assigned by the Public Range officials - please follow their directions.

Walk-Through Policy

Per rule 1.9, registered competitors may inspect the courses of fire provided the stages in question are not occupied by a squad or being worked on by Event Officials. Inspection should be conducted from the shooting areas only. Props and targets may not be activated, reset or otherwise interfered with.

Event Schedule

The squad schedules are shown on pages 8 & 9. Please be at your assigned stage before the appointed time. The stage briefings will begin promptly, followed immediately by the 5-minute walk-through period. Competitors who arrive late within their allotted time window may still shoot but may not receive a formal briefing/walk-through and this will not be grounds for a reshoot.

Lunch

Squads will break for lunch according to the published schedule.

There will be no on-site food vendors this year so please plan accordingly.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION & MATCH POLICIES

Firearm Handling & Chamber Flags

Rio Salado Sportsman's Club has a cold range policy, meaning that firearms must remain unloaded at all times except under the direction of an Event Official or Range Officer. Firearm handling may only be conducted in designated locations (see rule 2.3). When transferring a long gun to/from a gun cart, please be mindful of muzzle direction to avoid falling afoul of rule 2.4.5.

Open Bolt Indicators ("chamber flags") are required. During the Make Ready sequence, the competitor should give their chamber flag to an Event Official – the Official will re-insert or hand back the chamber flag during the Unload & Show Clear sequence.

Written Stage Briefings

The courses of fire may differ from those shown in this book; the versions posted at the stages take precedence. All vision barriers and walls are classified as hard cover and are presumed to extend down to the ground and up to the height as built unless otherwise stated in the Written Stage Briefing. Open fault lines are deemed to extend infinitely. No-Shoot targets and barriers are not always shown. Please inspect each stage carefully and ask Officials for any clarifications before you shoot.

Sight Pictures

Per rule 1.10, competitors may take a brief sight picture during the Make Ready procedure. Sight pictures must be taken offhand while standing at the start location; competitors may not assume other positions or rest on props while taking a sight picture.

Event Officials

Officials are here to ensure a safe and equitable competitive environment. Please follow their instructions and heed any warnings they may give. If they feel that your gun handling has become unsafe, they will take immediate corrective action even if no prior warning has been given.

Unsafe Firearms or Ammunition

You are responsible for using safe ammunition in a safe gun. Any firearm or ammo deemed by the Range Master to be unsafe must be withdrawn from the match until corrected to the Range Master's satisfaction. Unsafe ammunition may also be subject to rule 2.4.3. Firearm changes must be approved by the Range Master beforehand.

Target Calibration

The falling and reactive steel targets at this match have been adjusted to fall/react when hit with factory 9mm ammunition fired out of a 16" barrel. Target malfunctions and adjustments will be governed by rule 6.1.4 (not the same as USPSA).

Time Limits

Per rule 6.1.14, all stages are timed from the audible start signal to the last shot fired and are subject to a 120 second time limit ("par time").

Target Review

On some stages, Event Officials may begin scoring targets during the course of fire. If you want to have your targets checked by your delegate, please arrange for that to happen. A scored target that is subsequently pasted before the competitor can see it personally will not be grounds for a reshoot.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION & MATCH POLICIES

Lost Brass

Fired cartridge cases are the property of the event officials assigned to that stage. Please leave all brass where it falls. This policy applies for the duration of the event, from the start of the Staff Match through the end of tear-down on Sunday.

Arbitration

The arbitration process is governed by rule 1.13. To have a matter arbitrated, ask the stage CRO for an arbitration form, complete the arbitration form and submit it with your fee (\$100 cash) to the Range Master within one hour of the incident in question.

Taping & Resetting Targets

Competitors are required to help tape targets and reset the stage. Please do not reset targets until they have been scored. If in doubt, wait and ask an Official.

Steel Target Paint Refresh Policy

Closer-distance falling steel targets will be gray and will not be refreshed after the start of the match. Longer-distance steel targets will be blue and will be refreshed between squads if inside the confines of a bay, or once per day (overnight) if outside a bay.

Falling steel No-Shoot targets will be yellow and refreshed as needed at CRO discretion. Spinner target front surfaces will be gray and will not be refreshed, while the back surfaces will be red and refreshed as needed at CRO discretion.

Scoring

The primary score recording device will be the electronic tablet on each stage, with competitor's scores being emailed upon approval via PractiScore.

Once final scores are posted, competitors will have 30 minutes to protest any apparent errors. After the protest period has expired, all published scores will be deemed final.

Prize Awards, Demo & Vendor Areas

Prizes will be awarded to all competitors by random draw as their squads rotate through Stage 7, the demo area. Competitors must present themselves in person with their badge at their scheduled squad time. Prize bags will be prepared in advance and tagged with a raffle-type ticket. Each competitor will pick a ticket at random and immediately receive their prize bag. Some competitors will win FFL items, either a certificate to be redeemed later or a firearm in storage at the match FFL. The match FFL is Accuracy Speaks, located on premises. Processing fees apply (cash only please). Please arrange FFL transfers at times that will not conflict with your shooting schedule. Items not claimed within 90 days will be forfeited.

All exhibiting and sales must take place in designated Vendor Areas. Only authorized sponsors and exhibitors are permitted to trade in these areas. Any unauthorized persons found trading will be asked to leave the range.

Speed Limits, Parking Restrictions, RVs

In the interest of safety and to minimize dust, please drive responsibly and heed all speed limit signs. The site speed limits are 15mph on tarmac and 10mph on dirt. Drivers found speeding may be subject to the provisions of rule 1.6.

The "Restricted Parking" zones (indicated on the range map on page 31, and with signs) are off-limit to all motorized vehicles except those displaying a parking pass issued by the Range Master (usually for staff, vendors and disabled competitors only).



IMPORTANT INFORMATION & MATCH POLICIES

If you think you qualify for a parking pass, you can request one at the Registration Building.

Unauthorized vehicles found in the Restricted Parking areas will incur a +5-second procedural penalty for each passenger at whichever stage is closest to the location of the offense. Repeat offenders and non-competitors may be subject to the provisions of rule 1.6.

Competitors may park their RVs on the High-Power range just in front of the 500M awning. Upon arrival, RV owners should go to the range office and sign-in. Please pick a location that does not interfere with traffic flow, and bear in mind that RVs are tolerated by our host range as a courtesy - please respect any requests you might receive from range officials. Lastly, please be aware that the range gate closes automatically after 5pm - gate keys are available from the range office.

Alcoholic Beverages, Smoking

Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on Rio Salado Sportsman's Club property. At the time of writing, smoking is limited to inside vehicles only.

Climatic Conditions

It is the end of the AZ monsoon season. Be prepared for high heat (potentially over 100°F), elevated humidity, strong sun and even rain showers. Wear a hat and apply sunscreen. Most importantly, stay hydrated – water will be provided on all stages. Please put recyclable drink containers in the blue recycle receptacles, all other trash in the red trash receptacles.

Wildlife

Rio Salado Sportsman's Club is subject to AZ Game & Fish Department rules. Wildlife is not to be shot at or otherwise interfered with. This includes snakes.

If you encounter a snake, stay a safe distance away and notify a range official to have it humanely relocated.

Photography, Videography & Drone Policy

Recording of photographic and/or video imagery by competitors and spectators for personal use is permitted. Recording for commercial use must be approved in advance by the Match Director. Persons recording all such imagery (except the current shooter) must remain behind the rear-most fault line of the stage while it is being shot. The use of drones must be approved in advance by the Match Director.

In the event of a first-party arbitration, unedited imagery may be submitted as evidence for consideration subject to the provisions of rule 1.13.

Trophy Awards

Division trophies will be awarded according to division participation. A category trophy will be awarded for each category with more than one competitor; the winner will be determined first based on their percentage score within their division, then (in the case of ties) by stage percentage for their worst stage.

The award ceremony will be held as soon as possible after the protest period has ended, at which time, a number of additional high-value prizes will be distributed by random draw from amongst all finishing competitors - must be present in person to win.

I am aware of and understand and agree to follow the Four Firearm Safety Rules (*Treat all firearms as if they are loaded; never point a firearm at anything you are not willing to destroy; keep your finger off of the trigger and out of the trigger guard until you are on target and ready to fire; always identify your target as well as what is beyond and around it*) at all times. I understand that I am also responsible for reviewing and following any/all additional Range Rules, policies and directions of the Match Director.

The word "operation" includes safe handling, loading, unloading and firing of the firearm(s) as well as the appropriate safety mechanisms and operating features of each firearm.

I accept full and complete responsibility for the inherent risks resulting from my and/or anyone else's use of reloaded ammunition.
